**1. Call to Order**

Mayor Hall called the regular meeting of the Sheridan City Council to order at 7:00 p.m.

COUNCIL MEMBER RADKE MOVED TO AUTHORIZE DISBURSEMENTS THAT HAVE BEEN, OR WILL BE MADE FROM NOVEMBER 1, 2010 TO NOVEMBER 30, 2010 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$525,197.77 PER THE REFERENCED AND ATTACHED TRANSFER OF FUNDS. Seconded by Council Member Camacho and approved unanimously.

a. Ordinances on Second Reading

1) ORDINANCE NO. 11-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER MUELLER MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 11-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2011 AND APPROPRIATING SUMS FOR DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2011 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2011 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATUTES OF THE STATE OF COLORADO AND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN. 2) ORDINANCE NO. 12-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER RADKE MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 12-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN SETTING THE MILL LEVY FOR THE GENERAL FUND PROPERTY TAXES AND THE MILL LEVY FOR THE PROPERTY TAXES REQUIRED TO PAY GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST TO BE COLLECTED IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2011. 3) ORDINANCE NO. 13-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER RADKE MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 13-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE. Seconded by Council Member Camacho and approved unanimously.

b. Emergency Ordinances

1) Ordinance No. 14-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER MUELLER MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 14-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN, COLORADO, AMENDING ARTICLE 17 “F” OF CHAPTER 56 OF THE SHERIDAN MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO FLOODPLAIN OVERLAY DISTRICT REGULATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Seconded by Council Member Radke and approved unanimously.

c. Ordinances on First Reading

1) Ordinance No. 15-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER RADKE MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 15-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REENACTING ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 30 OF THE SHERIDAN MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO FIRE CODE AND FIRE CODE STANDARDS AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR JANUARY 12, 2011. Seconded by Council Member Camacho and approved unanimously.

2) Ordinance No. 16-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER RADKE MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 16-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE SHERIDAN MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION. Seconded by Council Member Camacho and approved unanimously.

3) Ordinance No. 17-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER WEST MOVED TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 17-2010, AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN ENACTING ARTICLE XXX OF CHAPTER 56 OF THE SHERIDAN MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE PROHIBITION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA CENTERS, OPTIONAL PREMISES CULTIVATION OPERATIONS AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA-INFUSED PRODUCTS MANUFACTURERS. Seconded by Council Member Smith and approved unanimously.

d. Resolutions

1) Resolution No. 39-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER SMITH MOVED TO APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 39-2010, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN APPOINTING POYSTI & ADAMS, LLC, TO AUDIT THE CITY’S FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2010. Seconded by Council Member Mueller and approved unanimously.

2) Resolution No. 40-2010

COUNCIL MEMBER WEST MOVED TO APPROVE RESOLUTION NO. 40-2010, A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHERIDAN APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SHERIDAN AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ARAPAHOE REGARDING DISPATCH SERVICES. Seconded by Council Member Smith and approved unanimously.

**13. Mayor's Choice**

Mayor Hall asked how Council wished to respond to the request made by Shane Wright for a letter of support. COUNCIL MEMBER MUELLER MOVED A LETTER OF SUPPORT BE PREPARED FOR GROUNDWORK DENVER FOR THEIR WORK ON BEAR CREEK. Seconded by Council Member Radke and approved unanimously.

Mayor Hall noted the Volunteer Fire Pension Board had scheduled a hearing on February 16, 2011 and had requested that the City Attorney attend. It was consensus of Council that the City pay the City Attorney's fee to attend the hearing.

**14. Council Members' Choice**

Council Member West reported a business on old Hampden was upset about trash enclosure requirements.

Council Member Radke noted a Thanksgiving dinner had been held at the high school and sponsored by JJ & Associates. She suggested the City pay half the cost of the cook and custodian. Council Member Smith suggested the City cover the entire cost. City Attorney Hayashi reminded Council that any expenditure must serve a public purpose. City Manager Krieger will research the matter further.

Council Member Radke noted she and City Manager Krieger would meet with Mr. Schroer regarding his concerns with trash collection in Sheridan.

She asked the status of the fuel issue with the school district. City Manager Krieger noted Michael Clough had submitted a request for records under the Colorado Open Records Act and that request was fulfilled.

**15. Public Comment**

Mr. Stan Mousel spoke to the roundabouts at River Point and his perception that they were dangerous. He also objected to the use of the photo radar van.
