



## Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, April 1, 2020 is Census Day for the United States of America pursuant to Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Census, a once-in-a-decade count of every person living in the United States, opened for self-response on March 12, 2020 and will continue through summer 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the correct allocation of billions of dollars in Federal funding for vital community programs including health, education, transportation, food assistance, emergency preparedness, disaster response, and representation in the U.S. House of Representative and Colorado State Legislature depend on the demographic data gathered during the 2020 Census; and

**WHEREAS**, individual responses collected by the Census Bureau are confidential and cannot be shared with any other government agency and any data released is only shared in aggregate form; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sheridan's Complete Count Committee has worked to ensure that *Everyone Counts* in Sheridan in the 2020 Census,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Sheridan, County of Arapahoe, State of Colorado, hereby proclaims April 1, 2020 as Census Day and the month of April 2020 as Census Month in the City of Sheridan.
